Hospice Care

Hospice is a holistic approach allowing patients to transition with dignity, comfort and peace. Hospice care addresses the physical, spiritual and emotional needs of patients and their families. At the end of life, hospice offers enhanced quality of life by managing symptoms when aggressive and invasive treatments are no longer effective or wanted.

Additionally, Altercare offers intimate gathering areas so families can savor secluded closeness. The on-site spiritual team provides a sense of peace and support through our Comsol program.

Considering hospice care for a loved one or yourself is never easy to talk about. In the final stage of life, though, hospice offers dignity, support and peace. When Is It time?

A hospice patient typically has a medical condition with a life expectancy of less than six months. The patient and/or family, in conjunction with the patient's physician, agree that the care goal is not treatment or cure, rather pain management and support for dignified final days.
